IN THE CLASSROOM

Hello Yellow Room Families! We have some really great activities planned for November!

During the first week, the theme will be Harvest! On Monday, we will focus on what a farmer does and the kids will trace a list of what jobs a farmer does. On Tuesday, we will focus on fruits and veggies by measuring some with counting cubes. On Wednesday, we will explore corn. On Thursday, we will focus on scarecrows and stack some hay counting how many we stacked. Lastly, on Friday, we will learn about farm animals and discuss which food comes from what animal.

For the second week, we will be focusing on Travel! On Monday, we will be exploring the continents by completing a magnet tile map puzzle where the kids will fill in the continents with magnet tiles. On Tuesday, we will be focusing on the Airport by making our own passports by tracing our name on it and stamping it. On Wednesday, we will be focusing on boats and doing an activity where we find items around the room and test whether they sink or they would make a good boat. Lastly, on Friday, we will be focusing on trains!

On Thursday, we will learn about Doctors and their medical supplies. Friday will be all about chefs! we will be doing a measuring cup activity with water and discussing how they are used in baking.

For the fourth week, we will be continuing our Thanksgiving Theme by focusing on Thanksgiving food and family time! We will be making mashed potatoes and talking about who is in our families.

During the fifth week, we will be learning about Winter! On Monday we will be learning about snow! On Tuesday we will be learning what animals hibernate and sorting them by whether or not they hibernate. On Wednesday, we will be covering winter clothes!
