The first week focuses on famous artists! On Monday, we will explore Monet with a math activity based on Monet's Boats painting where kids will use bowls as boats and count how many things they can fit in the boat before it sinks. Tuesday, we will learn about Van Gogh and Wednesday, we will learn about Picasso. Thursday will be all about Georgia O'Keefe with a flower letter matching activity at the literacy center. Week 2 is fairy tale week! Monday we will learn about castles with a science activity where kids build Elsa's castle out of ice cubes. The third week focuses on our favorite authors! Monday, we will be reading If You Give a Mouse a Cookie by Laura Numeroff. Tuesday, we will read Rainbow Fish by Marcus Pfister. Wednesday we will read The Very Hungry Caterpillar by Eric Carle and do a science activity where we put the butterfly life cycle in order. Thursday, we will read Goodnight Moon by Margret Wise Brown and remake the bedroom window from the book at art out of construction paper. Finally, Friday, We will read the Cat in the Hat by Dr. Seuss.

Week 4 is Earth Day themed! Monday, we will focus on the Earth and Earth Day in general with a literacy activity using the letter of the week, E! Kids will paint the letter E blue and green to make it an E for Earth! Tuesday will be recycling themed and Wednesday, We'll be focused on Dirt. Thursday will be ocean themed with an ocean clean up activity at math where kids will pick up "trash" and count how many piece they picked up. Lastly Friday, we will focus on the sky and the stars!
