## Our Growing Minds

We are officially in May! This month, our theme is "Our Growing Minds," and we have an exciting lineup of activities planned for the children.
In week one, we'll learn about the Farmer's Market and the Grocery Store.Our little learners will explore their favorite fruits and vegetables through spelling and writing them for literacy. For math, we will learn how to weigh our produce and read the numbers. In science, we'll learn how to properly wash our produce. And for art, children will create Happy Peas inspired by "The Carrot and The Pea."
For week two, we'll celebrate Mother's Day with heartfelt activities. Children will express their love for their moms through writing in literacy, and solve family puzzles in math. Science
experiments include creating color changing flowers, and art projects will involve drawing their mom's faces. Week three, we'll delve into the fascinating world of bugs and insects! Literacy will involve crafting a name caterpillars. For math, we'll see our children sorting out different critters. Science will be hands-on with bug fossil making, and in art- children will be making abstract bugs.
