SCHOOL**

This month at school

Welcome to Orange Room! This month's theme is Back to School!

For the first week of September, we will be learning all about me and my school. The letter of the week will be "Aa", and our sight word is "now". For literacy, children will be learning to identify, read, and spell their names. For math, children will be learning to write their parents phone numbers and learning their birthdays. For art, children will be making friendship bracelets using fruit loops. For science, we will work on using scissors and just the right amount of glue. Our water table will be filled with little people, rice, and cups.

For the second week of September, we will be learning all about our five senses and how they work. For literacy, children will label and write the parts of the five senses on a body cutout and write objects we can hear on lined paper. For math, children will sort the pictures to their corresponding sense, play the five senses matching game, and explore the sense of sight by counting the jellybeans and creating a graph. For science, children will get to explore items that taste bitter, sweet, sour, and salty. They will also explore their sense of smell by smelling several jars with different scent and will describe what they smell. For art, we will explore our five senses through painting with Kool-Aid, shaving cream, bubble wrap, and musical bell brushes.

For the third week of September, we will be learning all about the fall, and focusing on leaves and trees. The letter of the week will be "Cc", and our sight word will be "the". For literacy, children will be writing the different names of trees. For math, we will be measuring the different size acorns and doing some pinecone sorting. For science, we will build a bird feeder for our playground. For art, we will be painting a picture using pinecones. Our water table will be filled with leaves, hay, and pinecones.

For the fourth week of September, we will learn all about apples. For literacy, children will work on writing the upper- and lower-case letters, play apple BINGO, work on consonant vowels, and write apple words. For math, children will work on ten frames, count seeds from a real apple, and graphing how many seeds they have. For science, children will create the life cycle of an apples, experiment on making apple juice, and taste different types of apples. For art, children will create an apple wreath, candy apple craft, paint using real apples, and create an apple tree painting using Q-Tip's.

For the fifth week of September, we will learn and explore pumpkins. For literacy, children will work on sight words, beginning sounds, and trace uppercase and lowercase letters using pumpkin seeds. For math, we will work on geometric shapes by drawing different pumpkins shapes, write the missing numbers, and work on even and odd numbers. For science, kiddos will have fun exploring what is inside the pumpkin by using their magnifying glass and scoopers inside a real pumpkin, create a pumpkin diagram, and make a volcano in a real pumpkin. For art, children will paint a pumpkin shape, create a pumpkin pie craft, and create a pumpkin seed tree by using real pumpkin seeds.
