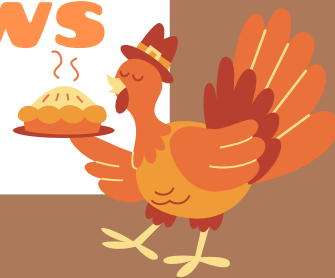

This month at school

Welcome to Orange Room! This month's theme is Happy Harvest!

For the first week of November, we will be discussing my community, and the letter of this week is letter J. We will be learning about our community helpers, and how they help in the community. For literacy, we will practice writing the community helpers words, work on beginning sounds, and rhyming words related to community helpers. For math, children will work on sorting, counting, work on geometric shapes, and compare quantities and volume. For science, we will learn how to care for a patient using doctor's tools, we will have a stem challenge to build a mailbox and learn to sort the garbage images in 3 category such as compost, waste, and recycling. For art, children will create a doctor's bag, police badge, mail carrier puppet, and recycling truck collage.

For the second week of November, we will be learning all about Thanksgiving. The sight word is "happy", and our letter of the week is "Kk". For literacy, children will be writing names of different Thanksgiving food and writing a book about what they are thankful for. For math, children will be playing Thanksgiving BINGO. For science, children will be making butter and pumpkin pie. For art, children will be making a turkey headband to wear during our Thanksgiving feast. Our water table will be filled with fake food, plates, and silverware.

For the third week of November, the theme is maps, gloves, travel. The letter this week is L. We will be learning structures around the world, what we need to travel, and how airports work. For literacy, we will create a passport, build continent words using letter beads, write a list of items to pack in our luggage when we travel, and play the matching game related to the continents. For math, we will be learning to count 5 by 5, counting flags around the world and try to write the symbol of least, greater, or equal. For science, we will create a diagram of the continents and label them, we will also learn about the animals around the world by sorting them in their habitat, and lastly, we will create a paper airplane experiment to observe how fast it can go. For art, we will create a continents craft, create planet earth, paint an airplane, and decorate an Eiffel tower with small buttons.

For the last week of November, it will be a short week, but we will be learning all about harvest. The letter of the week will be "Mm", and our sight word will be "how". For literacy, children will be walking around the room looking for farm animal's pictures and writing the names of the item on their clipboard. For math, we will be coloring a color by number of a farmer. For science, we will be learning how to milk a cow and bobbing for apples. For art, we will be making a corn mosaic and making a cow out of a paper plate. Our water table will be filled with hay, pipe cleaners, and fake corn.
