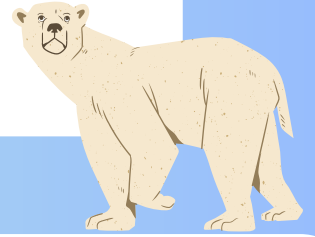

Welcome to Orange Room! This month's theme is Animal Habitats!

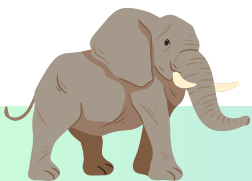
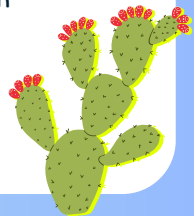
For the first week of January, we will still be closed for winter break and enjoying time with family and friends.

For the second week of January, we will be learning all about the rainforest and jungle. The sight word is "some", and our letter of the week will continue as "Oo". For literacy, children will be writing different birds names and tracing the different names of snakes. For math, children will be playing rainforest BINGO and creating a color by number of a toucan. For science, children will be making a rainforest in a bottle. For art, children will be building a monkey out of construction paper and making lily pads with coffee filters. Our sensory table will be filled with animals, green rice, and yarn.

In the third week of January, the theme is polar animals, and the letter of the week is P. We will be learning about the polar animals, and how they live in the arctic environment. For literacy, we will work on writing a journal about their favorite polar animal. For art, it will be all related to polar animals such as, polar bear paper plate, penguin craft, and painting an arctic fox. For math, we will measure polar animals using unifix cubes, trace and draw geometric shapes, and practice writing numbers. For science, we will experiment with blubber using vegetable shortening, sort arctic animals to their corresponding region, and create a diagram of an arctic fox.

For the fourth week of January, we will be learning all about the rainforest and the grassland. The sight word is "bye", and our letter of the week will be "Qq". For literacy, children will be writing different names of grassland animals. For math, children will be counting the lions on a ten frame and going on a nature walk to see what they can find. For science, children will be making their own grassland biomes. For art, children will be using marbles to create the stripes on a zebra. Our sensory table will be filled with fake grass, animals, and beans.

In the fifth week of January, the theme is desert animals, and the letter of the week is R. We will be learning all about the desert animals and their habitat. For literacy, children will work on rhyming words, writing sight words, and writing desert animal names. For art, children will paint a cactus using a fork to create the spikes, make a mosaic lizard, create a camel craft, and stamp paint a paper plate snake. For science, we will experiment with a cactus sponge, and we will observe how much water a cactus can absorbed, we will explore how to make sand dough, and make a leaping lizard brew with vinegar, baking soda, and green food coloring. For math, we will work on identifying numbers and counting, we will also work on ABC patterns.
