Welcome to Orange Room! This month's theme is once upon a time!

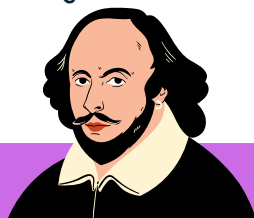
For the first week of April, we will be continuing to learn about weather. The sight word is "if", and our letter of the week will be "Aa". This week will be a bit different as we are focusing on working as a team. All our centers will be done in groups. For literacy, children will be labeling the different colors of the rainbow. For math, children will be blowing cotton balls into a bowl and counting how many they got, as we learn about the wind. For science, children will be using a mirror to try and create a rainbow. For art, children will be working together to create a giant sun for our classroom.

For the fourth week of April, we will be learning all about the earth day and recycling. The sight word is "look", and our letter of the week is "Cc". For literacy, we will be writing the different names of the flowers in our classroom garden. For math, we will be learning how to do addition using flowers. For science, we will be recycling items into the correct trash cans and creating a classroom garden. For art, we will be working as a group again to paint a garden on butcher paper.

For the last week of April, we will get very artistic! This week will be dedicated to all the famous artist such as, Vincent Van Gogh, Claude Monet, Pablo Picasso, Andy Warhol, and Georgia O'Keeffe. We will be learning their method of painting and their passion for art. For art, children will paint a celebrity pop art by Andy Warhol, recreate Vincent Van Gogh's Starry, and create a Pablo Picasso Mural. For literacy, we will write the names of the tool's artist use on lined paper, write the colors in Spanish, and write a journal on what is our favorite color and explaining why. For math, children will draw geometric shapes, count artist's tools, and sort pictures with lines and without lines. For science, we will explore painting in different forms of art, like painting with ice, painting with cinnamon scent, and painting with bubbles!
